

Dress Code

FBCS is committed to training young people in such a way that Christ is exalted in every area of life. Therefore, our students are expected to dress in a modest and appropriate manner and abide by our standards of dress.

All students grades K-5 must wear collared FBCS logo shirts on non P.E. days.

All students grades 6-H.S. must wear collared FBCS logo shirts on all days.

Students in grades 2-8 must keep their shirts tucked in except during P.E. and recess.

Girls- K-4th

Girls – 5th - H.S.

Polo Shirts with school logo from Land's end
Uniform pants or Capris in Khaki or navy (no cargo pants)
Skirts that sit on top the knee or below the knee in khaki, navy or plaid (skirts must be the same length front and back)
Skorts that sit on top of the knee or below the knee in khaki, navy or plaid
Button down shirts with school logo from Land's End
Matching neckties(solid or plaid)
Solid color tights or leggings in navy, white, ivory
Knee socks in plaid, navy, white, ivory
Blazers with a school logo from Land's End

***** Please note the top of the knee is the top of the knee cap. Please do not purchase skirts or skorts that do not reach the top of the knee cap as your child will not be allowed to wear them at school. If the skirt or skort is not the proper length your child will not be allowed in the classroom until they are in dress code***

Belts, Shoes, Socks, and Leggings

Solid colored belts and pants or shorts with belt loops must be worn in grades 2-H.S. Students may wear loafer style shoes, boat shoes, Mary Jane on non P.E. days. **Solid colored socks and leggings must be worn with shoes at all times. Students must wear sneakers on P.E. days.** No "wheelies" (shoes with wheels) or light up sneakers or boots are allowed.

P.E. Uniforms

Students in grades K-5 may wear school P.E. shirts all day on P.E. days. P.E. shorts are worn only by students in grades K-6 and only during P.E. class. Students in grades 7-8 must change from their uniforms to both P.E. shirts and shorts on P.E. days. P.E. uniform shorts must not be rolled at the waist of cuff. **P.E. shorts must be no shorter than the student's tip of the index finger when the arms are held flush against his/her side.**(P.E. uniforms are available for purchase all through the school year in the school office).

***A Uniform Exchange is available to all families in our school. Inquire in the school office for more details (see page13).**

Hair

Boys must not have bangs below the eyebrows. The length of side hair should not exceed the bottom of the earlobe. The back of a boy's hair must not exceed the bottom the shirt collar.

Girls' hair must be kept out of their eyes and bangs must not be below the eyebrows. No hair streaking of any color is allowed.

The Headmaster reserves the right to make final judgment on unconventional hairstyles.

Jewelry and Cosmetics

A limited amount of jewelry is allowed and is up to the discretion of the headmaster. Specifically prohibited are the following: ornate, gothic, skull jewelry, silly bands, or wire drop earrings. Stud style earrings may be worn by girls. Students may not wear nose, eyebrow, tongue, or belly button piercing. Boys may not wear earrings. Modest make-up is allowed for middle school girls. Any heavy make-up will be addressed by the Headmaster or Dean.

Outerwear

Sweatshirts, hoodie and sweaters must be purchased through Land's End and have the FBCS logo.

Dress Code Violations

Students in grades K-5 will receive dress code violation form to be signed by the parent. The 3rd violation the parent will be called to bring the student into dress code. Middle school students will receive demerits toward Saturday School (see page 23).
