Payment Options

- A 2% discount is applied for tuition paid in full (*by cash or check*) by Aug 1st.
- Monthly payments are due Aug through May. FACTS Tuition Management set up is required.
- Books fees due before July 20th or will be added to August FACTS.
- Step Up and MacKay scholarships accepted, scholarship paperwork is required at enrollment.

Withdrawal Policy:-Registration, Book & Activity Fee are not refundable; refunds for tuition are given on a pro-rated scale based on withdrawal date. Technology must be returned within seven days of withdrawal date.
